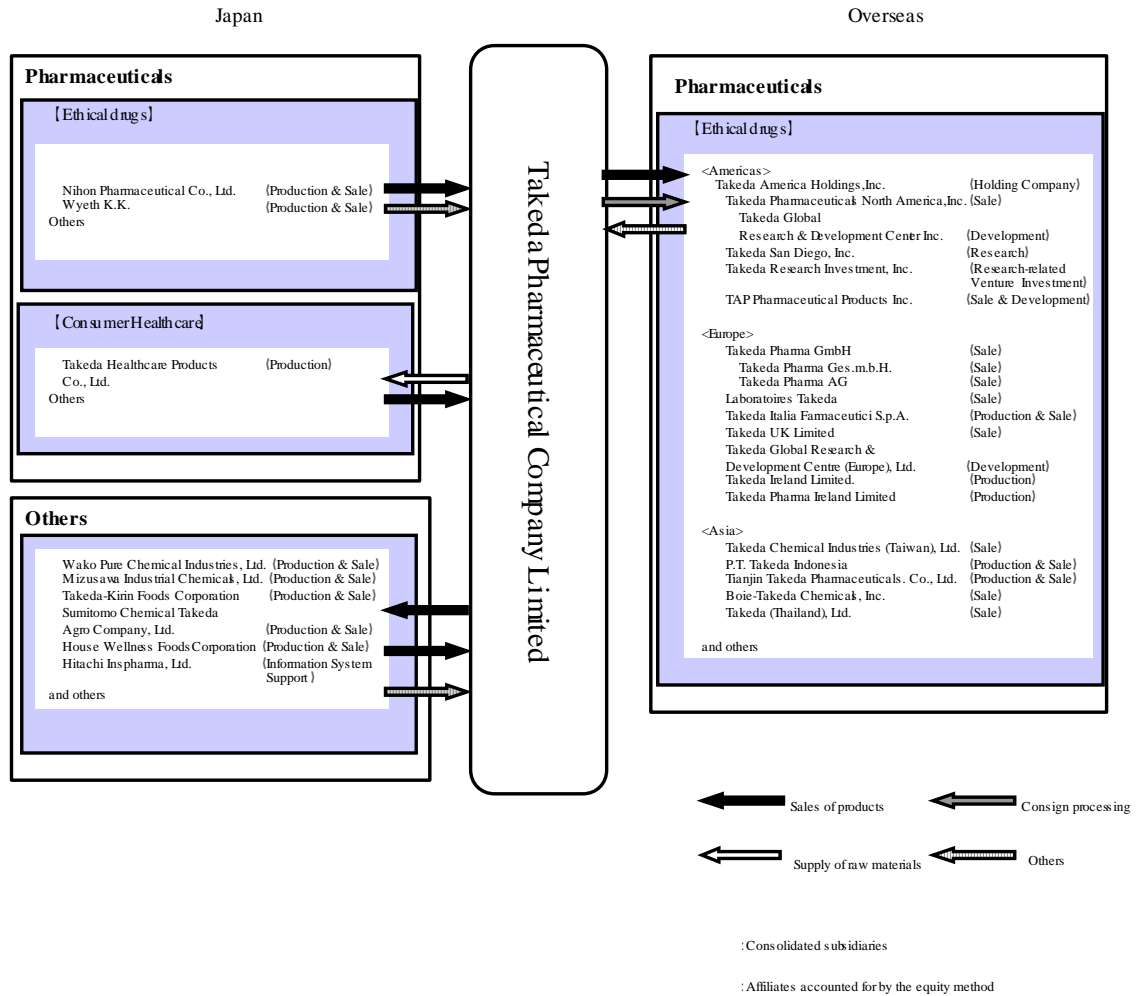


. Overview of subsidiaries and affiliates

The Takeda Group consists of 67 companies, including the parent company submitting these consolidated financial statements, 46 consolidated subsidiaries and 20 affiliates accounted for by the equity method.
