




Attendance Card for the General Meeting

Attendance

If you wish to attend the General Meeting, please sign this attendance card and present it at the registration desk to authenticate your right to attend. You will receive a poll card at the General Meeting after registering at the registration desk. It is intended that the resolution voted upon at the General Meeting will be subject to a poll (rather than a show of hands) which means that a shareholder has one vote for every share held. The voting procedure will be explained at the General Meeting.

You are encouraged to complete and return the Form of Proxy that accompanies this attendance card even if you wish to attend the General Meeting. Doing so will not prevent you from attending, voting or speaking in person at such meeting, but will ensure that your vote is counted if you are unable to attend.

If you are unable to attend the General Meeting, you are entitled to appoint another person or persons as your proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend the meeting and to vote and speak on your behalf. 1. THAT for the purposes of giving effect to the Scheme:

(A) the directors of the Company be authorised to take all such action as they may consider necessary or appropriate for carrying the Scheme into effect; For Against Withhold

(B) the articles of association of the Company be amended by the adoption and inclusion of a new Article 154; and For Against Withhold

(C) conditional upon and with effect from the sanctioning of the Scheme by the Court, the Company, or such other person as may be appointed by the Company, be appointed as agent of the Scheme Shareholders for the purposes of undertaking and carrying into effect any and all such steps, actions, matters and procedures as may, in the opinion of the agent, be considered necessary, desirable or appropriate pursuant to Japanese law (including, in particular, under Articles 203 and 204 of the Japanese Companies Act (Act No. 86 2005) (*kaisha hou*)) in connection with the alignment, issue and settlement of the New Takeda Shares pursuant to the Scheme. Form of Proxy – Explanatory Notes

1. Full details of the resolution to be proposed at the General Meeting, with explanatory notes, are set out in the Notice of General Meeting which is set out in the Scheme Document. Before completing this Form of Proxy, please also read "Action to be Taken: Voting at the Shire Meetings" set out in the Scheme Document. Terms defined in the Scheme Document shall apply in this Form of Proxy unless the context otherwise requires.
2. Only Shire Shareholders, or their duly appointed representatives, are entitled to attend, speak and vote at the General Meeting. A Shire Shareholder may appoint one or more proxies (provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise rights attached to a different share or shares), who need not be Shire Shareholders, to exercise all or any of his/her rights to attend, speak and vote on his/her behalf. Proxies may only be appointed using the procedures set out in this Form of Proxy and in these Notes. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If left blank, your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this Form of Proxy has been issued in respect of a designated account for a Shire Shareholder, the full voting entitlement for that designated account). Any proxy appointed pursuant to this Form of Proxy will vote as indicated by this Form of Proxy on the Scheme. For any other business arising at the General Meeting (including any procedural motion or resolution not listed in the Notice of General Meeting) the proxy appointed pursuant to this Form of Proxy will vote at his/her sole discretion.
3. This Form of Proxy (i) in the case of an individual must either be signed by the appointor or his/her attorney or authenticated in accordance with the Company's articles; and (ii) in the case of a corporation must be either given under its common seal or be signed on its behalf by an attorney or a duly authorised officer of the corporation stating their capacity or authenticated in accordance with the Company's articles of association. Any signature on or authentication of such appointment need not be witnessed. Where an appointment of a proxy is signed on behalf of the appointor by an attorney, the power of attorney or a copy thereof certified notorally or in some other way approved by the directors of the Company must (unless previously registered with the Company) be submitted to the Company, failing which the appointment may be treated as invalid.
4. The appointment of a proxy will not prevent a Shire Shareholder from subsequently attending and voting at the General Meeting in person. If a Shire Shareholder appoints a proxy or proxies and then decides to attend the General Meeting in person and vote on a poll using his/her poll card, then the vote in person will override the proxy vote(s). If the vote in person is in respect of the Shire Shareholder's entire holding then all proxy votes will be disregarded. If, however, the Shire Shareholder votes at the meeting in respect of less than the Shire Shareholder's entire holding, and the Shire Shareholder indicates on his/her polling card that all proxies are to be disregarded, that shall be the case; but if the Shire Shareholder does not specifically revoke proxies then the vote in person will be treated in the same way as if it were the last received proxy and earlier proxies will only be disregarded to the extent that to count them would result in the number of votes being cast exceeding the Shire Shareholder's entire holding.
5. To be valid, the Form of Proxy, and any power of attorney or other authority under which it is executed (or duly certified copy of any such power or authority), must either be (a) sent (or delivered by hand during normal business hours) to Equiniti (Jersey) Limited, c/o Equiniti Limited at Aspect House, Spencer Road, Lancing, West Sussex, BN99 6DA, United Kingdom, or (b) lodged using the CREST electronic proxy appointment service in accordance with the procedures set out in the CREST manual, in each case, so as to arrive no later than 11.30 a.m. (London time) on December 3, 2018 or, if the General Meeting is adjourned, 48 hours before the time fixed for the adjourned General Meeting. A stamp is not required if posted in Great Britain, the Channel Islands or Northern Ireland. Alternatively, you can appoint a proxy electronically by visiting www.sharevote.co.uk. You will need your Reference Number, Card ID and Account Number printed on the Form of Proxy. A proxy appointment made electronically will not be valid if sent to any address other than that provided or if received by Equiniti after 11.30 a.m. on December 3, 2018 (or, in the case of an adjourned meeting, later than 48 hours prior to the time and date set for the adjourned meeting). Please note that any electronic communication found to contain a computer virus will not be accepted. A proxy appointment sent by CREST may be treated as invalid in the circumstances set out in Article 34 of the Companies (Uncertificated Securities) (Jersey) Order 1999. 6. Please indicate with an 'X' in the relevant box how you wish your vote to be cast. Unless otherwise instructed, the person appointed as proxy will exercise his/her discretion as to how he/she votes or whether he/she abstains from voting on the resolution and on any other business (including amendments to the resolution and any procedural business, including any resolution to adjourn), which may come before the General Meeting.
7. The "Withheld" option on the Form of Proxy is provided to enable you to abstain on the resolution. However, a vote withheld is not a vote in law and will not be counted in the calculation of proportion of votes 'For' and 'Against' the resolution.
8. Only those Shire Shareholders registered in the register of members of the Company as at 6.30 p.m. (London time) on December 3, 2018 or, if the General Meeting is adjourned, 6.30 p.m. (London time) on the date falling two calendar days before the date appointed for such adjourned meeting, will be entitled to attend or vote at the General Meeting in respect of the number of shares registered in their name at that time. Changes to entries on the relevant register of members after 6.30 p.m. (London time) on December 3, 2018, or, if the General Meeting is adjourned, 6.30 p.m. (London time) on the date falling two calendar days before the date appointed for such adjourned meeting, will be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend or vote at the General Meeting.
9. If you wish to appoint more than one proxy in respect of your shareholding, mark the box where indicated and photocopy the Form of Proxy or contact Equiniti, by telephone on 0330 123 5506 (from within the UK) or on +44 (0)121 415 0856 (from outside the UK) for further Forms of Proxy. In the case of joint members, where more than one of the joint members purports to appoint a proxy or to vote in person on the same poll, only the appointment or vote submitted by the most senior member will be accepted. Seniority is determined by the order in which the names of the joint members appear in the Company's register of members in respect of the joint shareholding (the first named being the most senior).
11. Any body corporate which is a member may, by resolution of its directors or other body corporate, appoint any person as it thinks fit to act as its representative who shall be entitled to exercise the same powers on behalf of the corporation which he represents as that body corporate could exercise if it were an individual member present at the meeting in person.
12. Any alterations to this Form of Proxy must be initialled by the person who signs it.
13. Neither the death nor the insanity of a Shire Shareholder who has appointed a proxy, nor the revocation by a Shire Shareholder of the proxy or of the authority under which the appointment was executed, nor (until entered in the register) the transfer of the share in respect of which the vote is given, shall invalidate the vote given in accordance with the terms of the proxy, unless notice of such death, insanity, revocation or transfer shall have been received by the Company at the office or such other address specified for receipt of the Forms of Proxy not less than 12 hours before the commencement of the General Meeting or adjournment thereof.
14. You may not use any electronic address provided either in this Form of Proxy, in the Notice of General Meeting or in any related documents to communicate with the Company for any purposes other than those expressly stated.
