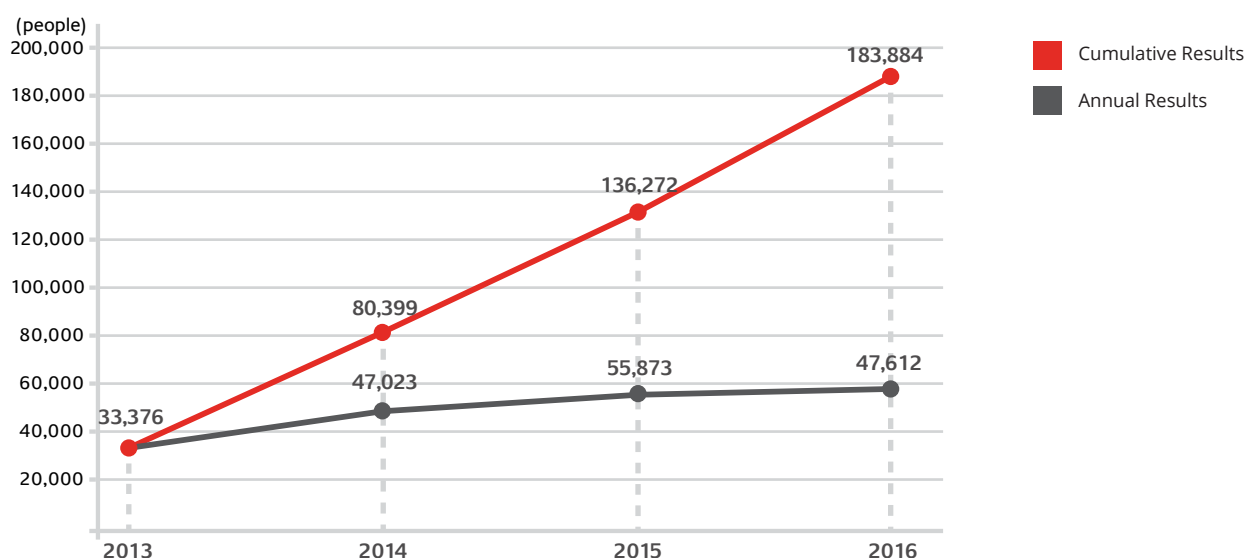


Takeda's support is aimed at contributing to the national goal to expand HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment, care and support in Nigeria in order to reduce HIV incidence and its associated morbidity and mortality.

The program goals include: to reduce new HIV infections, and improve the quality of life for the infected and affected; to provide Nigerians with universal access to prevention, diagnosis, and treatment services for drug-resistant TB by 2020; and to contribute to the restoration of public confidence in primary health care services in Nigeria and thereby increase the utilization of primary health care facilities.
