

# Program Outline

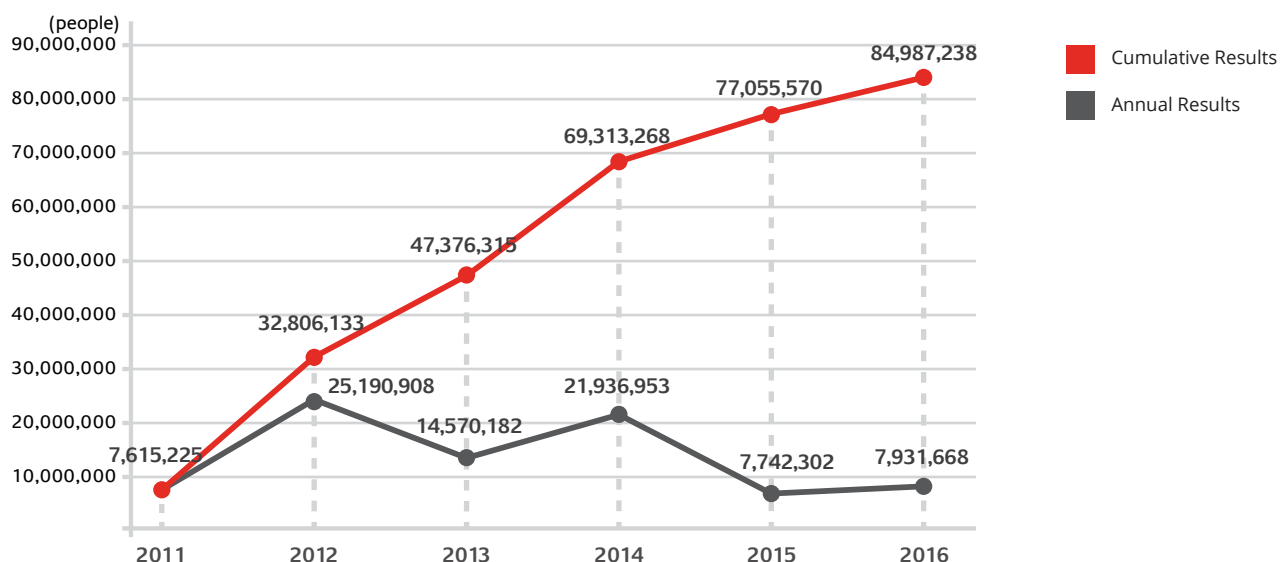
