Following review of the request for Grant for Rigshospitalet, Hemophilia Center, for Patient Educational Program, 2019 in Copenhagen, Shire Nordic-Baltic Sweden Regional Office, Vasagatan 7, 111 20 Stockholm will be able to offer support of DKK 83.833 (the "Support"). The Support may only be used for this intended purpose. For the avoidance of doubt, the Support may not, in whole or in part, be used for entertainment.

Payment of the Support will be made with the Recipient solely responsible for the settlement of any tax.

The Support is provided in accordance with all relevant laws, regulations and applicable industry codes. The offer of this Support is in no way contingent on the prescribing promotion or recommending of any pharmaceutical product; the Recipient confirms that Shire has no influence or involvement whatsoever in any decisions made by the Recipient and that the Support is provided as an independent educational grant. Moreover, the Support will be under the following terms (as applicable):

- The Recipient commits to comply with all relevant laws, regulations and codes including (without limitation), anti-bribery/anti-corruption laws, data privacy laws and all applicable laws relating to patient informed consent.
- The Recipient agrees to provide Shire with details of account into which the Support should be paid and a written receipt in respect of the payment.
- Shire reserves the right to review and comment on any planned publications that arise from the Recipient as a direct result of the Support. Any planned publication will be sent to Shire for review ten (10) working days before submitting the publication to the media concerned. Shire commits to complete this process within these ten (10) working days from the date of notification. In the event Shire has comments, those will be reasonably considered before the final publication.
- Shire may ask for a final (or interim) report of the use of the Support. Where applicable, this may include educational meeting evaluations



- Shire reserves the right to request a refund of unused funds within an appropriate time frame relevant to the activity.
- Any further support or extension of the Support shall be subject to another agreement between Shire and the Recipient and need to be agreed upon in writing in advance.
- Shire may request the right to review the content of an educational meeting for medical accuracy and for compliance with applicable code(s).
- Shire may publically declare details of the Support connected with the project/meeting/purpose, including but not limited to the name and address of the Recipient, amount paid and purpose of the Support.
- The Recipient is advised to publically declare Shire's Support.
- Where educational grant is provided to an individual Shire is required pursuant the EFPIA Code on Disclosure of Transfers of Value from Pharmaceutical Companies to Healthcare Professionals and Healthcare Organisations and/or national implementations thereof, to document and publicly disclose details of payments (including fees, travel, accommodation and any out of pocket expenses) to healthcare professionals. Please find enclosed a separate consent letter seeking your consent for such disclosure.
