

# Program Outline



The program goals include: training of community health care workers; nutritional support for TB patients; contact tracing of smear positive cases; and TB screening among prisoners. Within the framework of training the health care workers, the program aims at building capacity on screening TB patients and people living with HIV/AIDS, community based-Directly Observed Treatment (DOTS), nutritional assessment and management, and operations research, and cough monitoring.
